



Covid-19 Updates for October 19, 2020

Dear Residents, Families, and Friends,

This brief message is to inform you that we have had another Independent Living resident test positive for Covid-19 today on our Greensburg campus. We are in the process of retesting all of our IL residents on the Greensburg campus, using the PCR test. Please keep in mind that this test is more accurate but takes several days for us to receive results.

Residents are reminded to report symptoms to their Housing Assistant or Campus Director as soon as possible, even if they think that these symptoms may simply be a cold. Covid often presents with symptoms that are very much like a common cold.

Once again, I implore you to follow all of the guidance that we have given you over the past months. Please wear your masks, covering your mouth and nose. Maintain that six feet of distance whenever you are in the presence of someone who is not your housemate. Wash your hands frequently. Please consider using our personal shopper service or asking your family to shop for you, rather than going out to the stores. Please avoid going to restaurants and other public spaces where people remove their masks. The situation in Westmoreland County remains critical, and we all must do our part to help control the spread in our Redstone communities.

We will be back in touch when we have more information from our testing. Please keep our residents and Redstone family in your prayers.
