



Covid-19 Updates for October 5, 2020

Dear Residents, Families, and Friends of Redstone,

Today we learned that three of our Independent Living (IL) residents on our Greensburg campus have tested positive for Covid-19. Our prayers are with these residents. We are currently completing our contact tracing and those who need to be tested and isolated will be notified. We will also test any residents who are symptomatic and may expand that testing to asymptomatic residents if it is appropriate. Our testing protocols continue as related to employees who have traveled, are symptomatic, or have been exposed.

As of tomorrow morning (Tuesday), the following will occur on our Greensburg campus:

- In-person activities will be cancelled for Independent residents
- the IL Dining Room will be closed and meals will again be delivered as requested
- the Gift Shop will be closed but personal shopper service will be offered on Wednesday and Friday of this week. Please drop your orders in the box outside of the gift shop.
- IL residents may not visit the Bistro, Beauty Salon, or Fitness Center
- IL residents may not cross levels of care and may not visit residents from other levels of care.

We are limited in our authority in closing our Independent Living apartment buildings. Simply put, IL residents are independent. Still, we strongly encourage our IL residents to limit their movement about the building, maintain social distancing of six feet or more, and wear face masks at all times when leaving their apartments. We strongly discourage visitors to the IL apartments at this time. The cases in this area continue to escalate, and our vigilance is required at this time.

Operations will remain as normal for the Nursing Home and Personal Care Home in Greensburg, including our in-person visitor program. Operations for the Murrysville and North Huntingdon campuses will remain as normal.

We will keep you notified if there are further developments.
