

# MEMO

I have great news to share with you! We are making progress with scheduling all of our residents for their Covid vaccines. Until now, we have only been able to vaccinate employees and residents connected to our Skilled Nursing Facility; but we are beginning to see movement for vaccines for our other campuses and other levels of care.

Our entire Murrysville campus will have an opportunity to be vaccinated on Tuesday, January 19, 2021. This will include employees, Personal Care residents, and Independent Living residents. Legal representatives of Personal Care residents will be contacted to provide consent. Independent Living residents should follow this process:

1. Go to the front desk and ask the receptionist on duty for a copy of the VAR form. Take this form back to your apartment and fill sections A, B, and C out completely. In section A, for the LCTF Name put REDSTONE MURRYSVILLE. The address will be your own address. Answer all of the questions in section B. In section C, provide all of your insurance information. Make sure that you fill out sections A, B, and C completely.
2. Return your VAR to the receptionist. She will then schedule you for an appointment time between 10 am and 2 pm on Tuesday, January 19<sup>th</sup>.
3. Arrive to the chapel promptly for your appointment time on the 19<sup>th</sup>, and bring your insurance card and ID if you have one. Make sure that you are wearing your mask, and social distance during the vaccine clinic. You will need to stay for 15 minutes after being vaccinated to be monitored for reaction. (We had no reactions during our first clinic.)
4. Pharmacists will go door-to-door to vaccinate those in Personal Care.

While right now the Murrysville campus is the only campus to be scheduled for full vaccination, we trust and hope that North Huntingdon and the rest of our Greensburg campus will not be far behind. The vaccination is definitely the way forward from this pandemic. We hope for broad participation as we step forward in hope.
