



Late last night the CDC made some significant updates to their recommendations for nursing homes and personal care homes, as a result, we are updating our plan. These updates will occur by 3:00 pm today and are as follows:

- NO visitors will be permitted into the SNF or PCH's.
- We will move building access for visitors to only one door – the front doors – and prohibit access by visitors. All visitors will have to call into a receptionist or nurse for access.
- Residents will not be permitted to leave the building for visits with family,
- ALL snf and PCH residents MUST remain in their rooms. The dining rooms will be closed beginning with lunch today. Lifestyle activities will occur in resident rooms. We are working with some groups to provide some singing entertainment in courtyards that can be viewed out resident windows.
- The Bistro at Greensburg will be closed.
- Employee meals will be available in the breakrooms beginning tomorrow. Please be considerate of your fellow coworkers and take only one item available.
- All three of our reception desks will be staffed from 8:00 am – 8:00 pm 7 days per week.
- In addition to building specific leadership, corporate leadership has been assigned to specific buildings and will be present 7 days per week (on a rotating basis) for the duration of the Pandemic. Here are those assignments:
