



Dear Residents,

Here are your COVID-19 updates for Monday, March 30, 2020.

As you know, the Governor of Pennsylvania has extend the “Shelter-in-Place” order to Westmoreland County. This is due to the continued spread of COVID-19 in Westmoreland County.

Therefore, we are requiring all of our Apartment residents to join our Personal Care and Skilled Nursing residents in remaining on the Redstone campus at all times. By leaving the campus, they may be putting their own, or someone else’s, life at risk. This is a risk that we must not allow within our Redstone community.

Apartment residents may only leave the campus in the case of essential medical treatments, procedures, or appointments. Should an Apartment resident choose to leave the campus for reasons other than essential medical purposes, the resident will not be able to return to the campus until the pandemic has reached a level where their return would be safe for the Redstone community. We have legal grounds to enforce this policy. Again we remind you that this policy is implemented firmly and with love, in order to protect our entire Redstone family.

We encourage all residents to enjoy the outdoors, in appropriate weather. Please continue to avoid lingering or congregating in public spaces. Maintain your safe distancing, remaining 6 feet apart from others.

Along with this letter, we are sending you additional information about safe handwashing. We cannot stress the importance of handwashing enough!

We continue to closely monitor our staff and are following Department of Health policies. We are limiting the risk of exposure from our employees through temperature checks, wellness screening, and the use of masks when appropriate and necessary.

Every day, we hope to come to you with the news that we can begin to lift the restrictions that we have put in place to protect our Redstone community. Unfortunately, as the virus continues to spread, we are not yet to that point. We are going to recover from this crisis, but first we must get through it. It remains critically important for us to stay the course, uphold our policies, and be patient and supportive of one another. We must persevere together.
