



NO VISITOR POLICY
Monday, March 16, 2020

By order of the CDC and the Federal Government there is a state of emergency that calls for NO VISITING in Nursing Homes and Personal Care Homes. For the wellbeing of your loved ones, we are abiding by this NO VISITOR policy. Limiting the number of people that your loved one comes in contact with increases their ability to stay healthy during this pandemic. Should you have a family member who is near end of life, please call your Campus Director about possible accommodations.

Independent Living Residents must limit visitors to two at a time, and we strongly recommend that families consider not visiting, even in the IL apartments. Those who do visit must be immediate family members. Minimizing outside contacts will help to keep your loved ones healthy. IL residents may not visit or move about other levels of care. IL residents are encouraged to practice self-isolation as much as is practical and are discouraged from leaving the building.

All those who do enter our campus will be required to complete and pass a brief screening process and questionnaire. All visitors must enter through the FRONT DOOR to complete this screening process.



We are taking added internal precautions, as recommended by the CDC to keep our residents and staff safe.
