With great hope, and a touch of reasonable anxiety, we are beginning the process of preparing for Covid-19 vaccination clinics at Redstone. While the timeline and exactly how these clinics will be rolled out is still somewhat unknown, we want to make sure that we are ready to go when that day arrives. We have partnered with Walgreen's to be our vaccine provider at Redstone. Walgreen's will take care of all of the storage and administrative concerns related to the vaccine. They will come to the campuses to administer the first dose of the vaccine, and return at the appropriate interval for the second dose.

We are unsure if the first phase of vaccine administration will include all residents and employees within our Redstone communities, or if the first wave will only include Nursing Home residents and employees who care for them. We are anxious to have this information provided for us and will share it with you as soon as possible. We are advocating for every resident and employee across Redstone to be vaccinated as soon as possible. We believe that the vaccine is the way forward to protect our residents and begin recovery from this pandemic.

Enclosed you will find an information piece that we have put together from a variety of resources. We hope that it helps to answer any questions you might have about the vaccine. For residents who are unable to provide their own consent, the legal representatives of residents will be receiving a phone call from a team member at Redstone to discuss consent.

If you have questions or concerns, we encourage you to talk with your resident's PCP. Our team here is also available to talk with you. Thank you in advance for responding quickly as we prepare for this vaccination milestone.
