Dear Residents, Families, and Friends,

We know that it is early in the morning but we wanted to provide you with an update on our Covid-19 testing process on both our Greensburg and North Huntingdon campuses. As you know, we recently had a team member test positive on both of these campuses, in unrelated cases. These cases set off a required process of testing on both of these campuses. In North Huntingdon, we have not yet received any results from the testing that was done on employees and residents on Friday, September 4th. When we have these results, we will notify you.

So far, we have received results from 101 Personal Care and Skilled Nursing residents from our Greensburg campus. All of these tests are negative. We have received 215 results from the 253 employees who were tested on the Greensburg campus. Unfortunately, 3 of the employees who were tested had positive test results. As you are aware, positive Covid-19 results in asymptomatic individuals is one of the unusual realities of this virus. Last evening, we conducted contact tracing based upon these three positive results. Please know that if you (or your resident loved one) appears in our contact tracing, you will hear from us. At this time, we believe that there was minimal contact with our resident population. We anticipate receiving the results from any outstanding Greensburg tests within the next day. Once we receive these, we will update you.

Because of the positive test results in Greensburg, we will need to continue testing on a regular basis on this campus, until we have no additional positive cases. We know that the testing can be stressful and uncomfortable, but ongoing testing is the only way for us to determine that we have returned to zero cases and the safest of environments for our residents.

As the virus continues to spread, it has become harder to maintain the completely safe "bubble" that has surrounded our residents. Nevertheless, our infection control practices maintain the highest standards and we believe that we are well prepared to provide the best possible care and safety for our residents.

We know that this is an anxious time for all of you. We will continue to update you regularly and transparently throughout this ongoing testing process.
